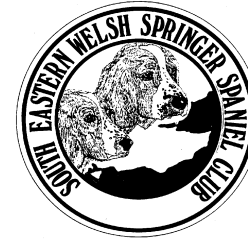

## Information and Definition of Classes

**CLASSES:** In the following definitions the term 'dog' refers to a dog or bitch that is registered at the Kennel Club as a Spaniel (excluding ESS and Cocker) in the Gundog group.

**PUPPY:** Between 6 and 24 months on the date of the assessment test.  
Walk to heel, sit & stay, recall, seen or simple unseen retrieve, Hunting.

### SPECIAL

**BEGINNERS:** Neither handler nor dog to have previously won any award in any test.  
Walk to heel, sit & stay, recall, seen or simple unseen retrieve, Hunting.

**NOVICE:** Not place 1<sup>st</sup> in a minor breed spaniel novice working test or 1<sup>st</sup> twice in a minor breed spaniel novice assessment test  
Not placed 1<sup>st</sup> in an AV novice test  
Not placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in an open working test or assessment test  
Not placed in awards or awarded COM in a Field Trial  
Not having been awarded a SGWC or KCWGC  
Hunting, steadiness to shot, seen/unseen retrieve, possible water Test

**OPEN:** Dogs will be required to work as under normal conditions  
The Judges may alter the above tests at their sole discretion

### CLOSING

**DATE:** Entries to be **RECEIVED** no later than **Saturday 11th May 2019**

**DUMMIES:** For Novice and Open dummies **MUST** be canvas in a natural colour (but not white) and approximately 1lb in weight. They may be covered in fur or feather

**TIME:** 9.00a.m. for a prompt 9.30a.m. start (N.B. Depending on the number of entries the start time may be brought forward to 9.00a.m. – you will be notified of an earlier start time by e-mail with at least 24hrs notice.

Would all current holders please ensure that they return trophies in good time.

**REFRESHMENTS:** All competitors should be self-sufficient. There will be a short break of 15minutes and then a late lunch break at approximately 2.00p.m. when all the assessments have taken place.

**RAFFLE:** There will be a raffle., donations of prizes would be most welcome.

**JUDGES MARKS:** The judges' marks for each element of your dog(s) tested will be made available to you (emailed if address given).

All dogs to be on lead at all times except when under the direction of the judge, or when allowed by the organisers. No dogs at risk of infection (see declaration on entry form), nor any bitch in season, will be allowed on the ground.

### DIRECTIONS

**SatNav postcode – DA13 0XT but look for SEWSSC signs.**

**FROM SW:** M25, M26 J2A (signposted Wrotham M20 Gravesend A227). Follow signs A20 Brands Hatch for 2 roundabouts. At 3<sup>rd</sup> roundabout follow signs for A227 Gravesend. Follow for 4.8 miles through Culverstone and Meopham. Turn Right into Green Lane, signed Sole Street. After about three quarters of a mile, at the entrance to Sole Street on a left-hand bend, look for and follow SEWSSC signs to the right.

**FROM SE:** M20 and briefly M26 to J2A, go under the motorway and follow directions as above.

**FROM N:** Leave M25 at J2 (A2) follow signs for Rochester and Dover, look for A227 to Wrotham and Meopham Green, which is just after Morrison's Superstore across the fields on your left. Follow road for 3 miles, then turn Left into Green Lane, signed Sole Street. After about three quarters of a mile, on a left-hand bend, at the entrance to Sole Street, look for and follow SEWSSC signs.

### GENERAL

We have the use of much of this land, BUT there are public footpaths and bridleways in the area, so beware of walkers and horses!

The land is used for shooting, so please keep disturbance to a minimum.

Please be considerate and pick up after your dog, and take your rubbish home, leaving the venue as we find it.
